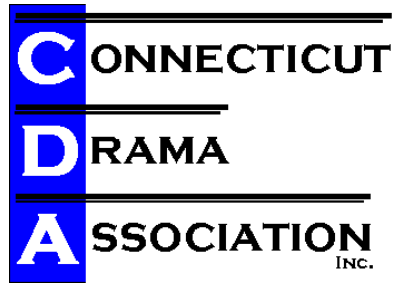

TO THE APPLICANT:

The Connecticut Drama Association is happy to sponsor the Armand Zimmermann Scholarship. Mr. Zimmermann was a pioneer and guiding force in the early days of the CDA. We can think of no better way to honor his memory than to help graduating high school students in their pursuit of their dreams in the various aspects of theatre.

Scholarships will be considered in each of the three areas of theatre work--- performance, design (including stage management), and theatre education.

REQUIREMENTS:

ALL APPLICANTS MUST:

1. be a student at a CDA-member school;
2. complete the scholarship application form;
3. complete a theater related resume;
4. have a minimum C+ cumulative grade average;
5. supply a copy of the acceptance letter from the college/ university/ conservatory that the candidate wishes to attend;
6. be a graduating senior;
7. supply a copy of his/her transcripts including the first semester senior year;
8. use the scholarship to major or minor in the communicative arts (theater, film, speech, radio, television).

IN ADDITION:

Students applying for the *performance scholarship* must submit a DVD or videotape (VHS) containing an audition that BEST represents the candidate's abilities. A maximum of five (5) minutes will be allowed during which at least one acting monologue is required.

The videotape should begin with an introduction of the candidate's name, school, performance pieces, and the candidate's telephone number. This introduction should take no more than thirty (30) seconds.

Applicants for the *design scholarship* must submit a portfolio including sketches, designs, photographs, etc. All portfolios will be returned. Stage Management candidates must submit a prompt book. These will be returned.

Applicants for the *theatre educator* scholarship must submit two (2) papers of no more than 250 words, responding to the following:

- Explain why you want to be a theatre teacher.
- Discuss what you feel is the most important issue facing high school theater arts today.

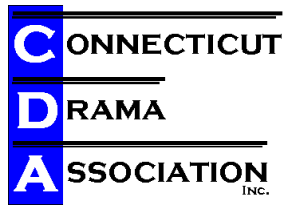
